There are 10 doubles events and 5 mixed doubles events with limitations in the configuration of the member of the pairs. The limits work all as follows:

Class MD4 Men's Wheelchair with the players' classes adding a maximum of 4.

Class MD8 Men's Wheelchair with the players' classes adding a maximum of 8.

Class MD14 Men's Standing with the players' classes adding a maximum of 14.

Class MD18 Men's Standing with the players' classes adding a maximum of 18.

Class MD22 Men's Doubles for class 11 athletes.

- Class WD5 Women’s Wheelchair with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 5.
- Class WD10 Women’s Wheelchair with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 10.
- Class WD14 Women’s Standing with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 14.
- Class WD20 Women’s Standing with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 20.
- Class WD22 Women’s Doubles for class 11 athletes.
- Class XD4 Mixed Wheelchair with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 4.
- Class XD10 Mixed Wheelchair with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 10.
- Class XD14 Mixed Standing with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 14.
- Class XD20 Mixed Standing with the players’ classes adding a maximum of 20.
- Class XD22 Mixed doubles for class 11 athletes.

Note: The final medal events program will be announced following confirmation of event viability after the Entry by Name.

ATHLETE QUOTA

The tournament will be open to all athletes from NPC belonging to Asian Paralympic Committee. A quota per NPC might be established if the entries by number received were higher than the following quota:

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- Be classifiable under the ITTF rules and regulations and provide medical reports required by ITTF before 15/08/2023.
- For class 11, only athletes registered on the Virtus Eligibility Master List and who already have an ITTF International Classification Card, closing date 31 July 2023, can be selected by their NPC.

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per single event, a maximum of two (2) pair per doubles medal event. ITTF will calculate ranking points for single and doubles event.

PARIS 2024 PARALYMPIC GAMES QUALIFICATION

This competition is sanctioned by ITTF, and the winners of each single event will be awarded a direct qualification slot for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games.

TIMELINE

31 March 2022	Deadline for the NPCs to respond in writing the Entry by Number to ITTF, APC and HAPGOC.
31 July 2023	Deadline for the NPCs to respond in writing the Entry by Name to ITTF, APC and HAPGOC.

EVENT ELIGIBILITY

At least four (4) players from two (2) different countries must enter per class, otherwise the event will be combined with another event. Only members of the same NPC can compete as a pair. ITTF may choose to combine classes at close of entry to ensure event viability.
