ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

The qualification slot is allocated to the Individual athlete and not to the NPC.

MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC

An NPC may be allocated a maximum of 25 athlete's slots.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- Be classifiable under the ITTF rules and regulations.
 - ⌘ For class 11, only athletes registered on the INAS Eligibility Master List and who already have an ITTF International Classification Card, closing date 01 May 2018, can be selected by their NPC.

MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC

An NPC may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per singles medal event.

An NPC may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team medal event with each team consisting of at least two (2) and a maximum of three (3) athletes who must each be entered in a singles medal event. Should the event be combined, then an NPC may enter a maximum of two (2) teams, with the same condition that the athletes must each be entered in a singles medal event.

An NPC may enter one (1) pair per medal doubles or mixed doubles event, but may enter two (2) pairs per medal doubles or mixed doubles event where the event is combined.

Each athlete can participate in a maximum of only two (2) events.

The ITTF calculates ranking points for singles matches only, be it in an individual singles event or a singles match in a team event. Doubles matches do not earn any ranking points."

TIMELINE

7 April 2018	Deadline for the NPCs to respond in writing the Entry by Number to ITTF, APC and INAPGOC.
31 July 2018	Deadline for the NPCs to respond in writing the Entry by Name to ITTF, APC and INAPGOC.
6-13 October 2018	Indonesia 2018 Asian Para Games

EVENT ELIGIBILITY

Individual Events: There should be a minimum of FOUR (4) athletes from TWO (2) participating nations in the Singles events and a minimum of Four (4) pairs from TWO (2) participating nations in the Doubles events.

Team Events: There should be a minimum of FOUR (4) participating nations.

ITTF may choose to combine classes at the close of entry to ensure event viability.
